Install Simple Analytics with Nuxt 3

We have a package that works with both Nuxt 2 and Nuxt 3.

Nuxt 3

Run this command to install Simple Analytics for Vue:

```
npm install simple-analytics-vue --save-dev
```

Create a file called plugins/simpleanalytics.client.js:

```
import SimpleAnalytics from "simple-analytics-vue"; export default
defineNuxtPlugin((nuxtApp) => { nuxtApp.vueApp.use(SimpleAnalytics); });
```

That's it! Continue only if you want to go advanced.

If you want to skip your own visits on development:

```
import SimpleAnalytics from "simple-analytics-vue"; export default
defineNuxtPlugin((nuxtApp) => { nuxtApp.vueApp.use(SimpleAnalytics, { skip:
process.env.NODE_ENV !== "production", }); });
```

If you have a <u>custom domain for bypassing ad-blockers</u> set up, use this:

```
import SimpleAnalytics from "simple-analytics-vue"; export default
defineNuxtPlugin((nuxtApp) => { nuxtApp.vueApp.use(SimpleAnalytics, { skip:
process.env.NODE_ENV !== "production", domain: "api.example.com" }); });
```

Nuxt 2

Run this command to install Simple Analytics for Vue:

```
npm install simple-analytics-vue@2.x --save-dev
```

Create a file in your plugin folder with the name simple-analytics.js:

```
// ~/plugins/simple-analytics.js import SimpleAnalytics from "simple-analytics-
vue"; import Vue from "vue"; Vue.use(SimpleAnalytics, { skip:
process.env.NODE_ENV !== "production" });
```

Then on your nuxt.config.js, make sure to include the plugin with ssr: false as we only want to run it on the client:

```
// nuxt.config.js export default { plugins: [{ src: "~/plugins/simple-
analytics.js", ssr: false }], };
```
