API Authenticate

For some API features you'll need to authenticate. You can do this with an **Api-Key** -header where the key starts with `sa_api_key_...`.

In your [account settings](#) you can create this key.

To test if your API key works correctly you can replace the example values of this cURL example with your own:

```
curl "https://simpleanalytics.com/example.com.json?version={{ site.api_version }}&fields=histogram" \
  -H 'Content-Type: application/json' \
  -H 'Api-Key: sa_api_key_XXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXX'
```

For some API calls you'll need a user ID:

```
curl "https://simpleanalytics.com/api/websites" \
  -H 'Content-Type: application/json' \
  -H 'Api-Key: sa_api_key_XXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXX' \
  -H 'User-Id: sa_user_id_00000000-0000-0000-0000-000000000000'
```
